

THE PFAU COURSE AT INDIANA UNIVERSITY

OPERATION PLAN

March 2021

The Pfauf Course at Indiana University will implement the following COVID-19 safety protocols for the 2021 golf season:

General Guidelines:

- Guests and staff must practice [physical distancing](#) (remaining six feet away from each other) at all times. To promote physical distancing, staff and guests should not congregate in high traffic areas. Facilities will be set up to ensure physical distancing.
- While inside and when physical distancing is difficult outside, all guests and staff must wear [face coverings](#). All guests must come to the Course with a face covering.
- Guests and staff should frequently [wash their hands](#) or use hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer will be available at high trafficked areas, such as check in. If a guest or staff member is feeling ill, they should contact their Primary Medical Provider and not come to the Course.

The George Thomas Family Clubhouse (“Clubhouse”) will open on a limited basis:

- The Pro Shop will be open, but guests will be expected to physically distance themselves from other guests. Signage will be in place to remind guests to follow these guidelines.
- The restrooms will be open and will be frequently disinfected, especially in high touch areas, in accordance with established EHS and VPCPF guidelines.
- Food and beverage service will be provided in the Clubhouse by Upland as outlined below.
- The Clubhouse will be frequently disinfected, with an EPA List N substance, during the day and at night.
- All guests will be required to wear face coverings while in the Clubhouse.
- All golf carts will be disinfected after each use.

Food and beverage service will be provided by Upland in the following manner:

- All services will be conducted within all IU EHS guidelines.
- All employees will be required to wear proper personal protective equipment, including gloves and proper face coverings.
- All indoor dining will be open at 25% capacity and tables will be placed to ensure they are at least 6 feet apart. Cards will be placed on each table indicating that the tables are not to be moved.
- There will be no self-served buffets. All food will be served or delivered by Upland staff.
- All guests will be required to wear face coverings unless seated at table eating and drinking.
- Guests will be permitted to sit at the tables on the patio and in the Pavilion. These tables will be spaced six feet apart.
- Bar Top seats will be removed.
- All high touch surfaces will be sanitized frequently with an EPA List N product.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout areas for both staff and guests.
